### ***Mental Maths / Maths***

Recognise numbers to 10 (exposure to 20)  
Count forwards to 20 and backwards from 10  
Subitising to 6  
Ordinal numbers  
Addition to 10 – number stories  
Before and after a target number  
Identify and name attributes of basic 2D shapes  
Colours – R, O, Y, G, B, P  
Patterns – copy, continue and create AB patterns (e.g. a, b, a, b)  
Basic positional language – on, in, under, beside, near, behind)  
Time – yesterday, today and tomorrow (calendar)  
Time of the day – morning, afternoon and night  
Sequence of events  
Days of the week and how many?  
Months of the year and how many?  
Seasons and how many?  
Language of size of measurement i.e. small to biggest  
Comparing units – heavier/lighter than  
Identifying Australian Coins  
How many finger on one hand and how many fingers on two hands?

### ***English, Spelling, Grammar***

Capital letters at the start of their own name (proper noun)  
Full stop at the end of a sentence (punctuation)  
Diagraphs (16)  
Vowels (5)  
Letters of the alphabet (26)  
Letter name and sounds (42)

Writing their own name and spell it  
Initial sounds, final sounds and medial sounds  
Identifying numbers of words in a sentence  
Syllables  
Rhyme – identifying and producing rhymes  
Onset and rime – Manipulation  
Dictation of CVC words  
Tricky hat words (exposure) blue list  
Able to identify correct sentence structure – Writing left to right, top to bottom, with spaces.

### **Poetry**

Nursery Rhymes  
Australian Poem/Song – We are Australians  
National Anthem (exposure)

### **HASS**

My family (names of family members)  
Flags (Aboriginal)  
Names (What is your name and surname?)  
Country and state we live in – Map of Australia

### **STEM / Science**

5 senses (touch, taste, sight, listen, smell)  
Weather

### **Phys Ed**

Jump, skip, hop, run, walk (automated responses)  
Left and right

### **Music**
